

ADMISSIONS ARRANGEMENTS FOR ENTRY TO SHENLEY BROOK END SCHOOL SIXTH FORM FOR SEPTEMBER 2013

The anticipated sixth form capacity for year 12 for September 2013 is 170.

Internal Students

The school welcomes applications for entry to Shenley Brook End School's sixth form from students who have attended the school in year 11 in 2012 and wish to transfer to the sixth form in September 2013.

External Students

The school also accepts applications for entry to the sixth form from external candidates who attended another school for year 11 during 2011-2012.

Entry Requirements for both Internal and External students

Entry to the sixth form is subject to a student having achieved the entry requirements for the course they wish to pursue and demonstrated an aptitude to study. Students should refer to the Sixth Form Prospectus for individual subject requirements for further details; individual subjects may be limited in the number of students they are able to accommodate.

Admissions Criteria for External Students

Should applications from suitable qualified external students exceed the number of places available, the following over-subscription criteria will be applied:

1. Looked after Children: this includes children who were in care but have since been adopted or become subject to a residence order or special guardianship order.
2. Students who live within the defined area and who have a sibling in years 7 – 11 at the time of admission. Proof of residence will be required.
3. Students who live in the area served by the school – the defined area. Proof of residence will be required.
4. Students who live outside the school's defined area but have a sibling in years 7 – 11 at the time of admission.
5. Students living outside of the defined area.

The defined area of the school is as follows: Emerson Valley, Furzton, Shenley Brook End, Tattenhoe and Westcroft.
