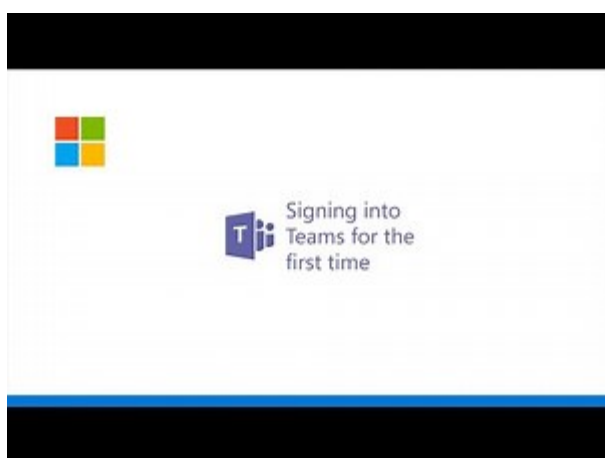


## Microsoft Teams Student / Parent Guidance
