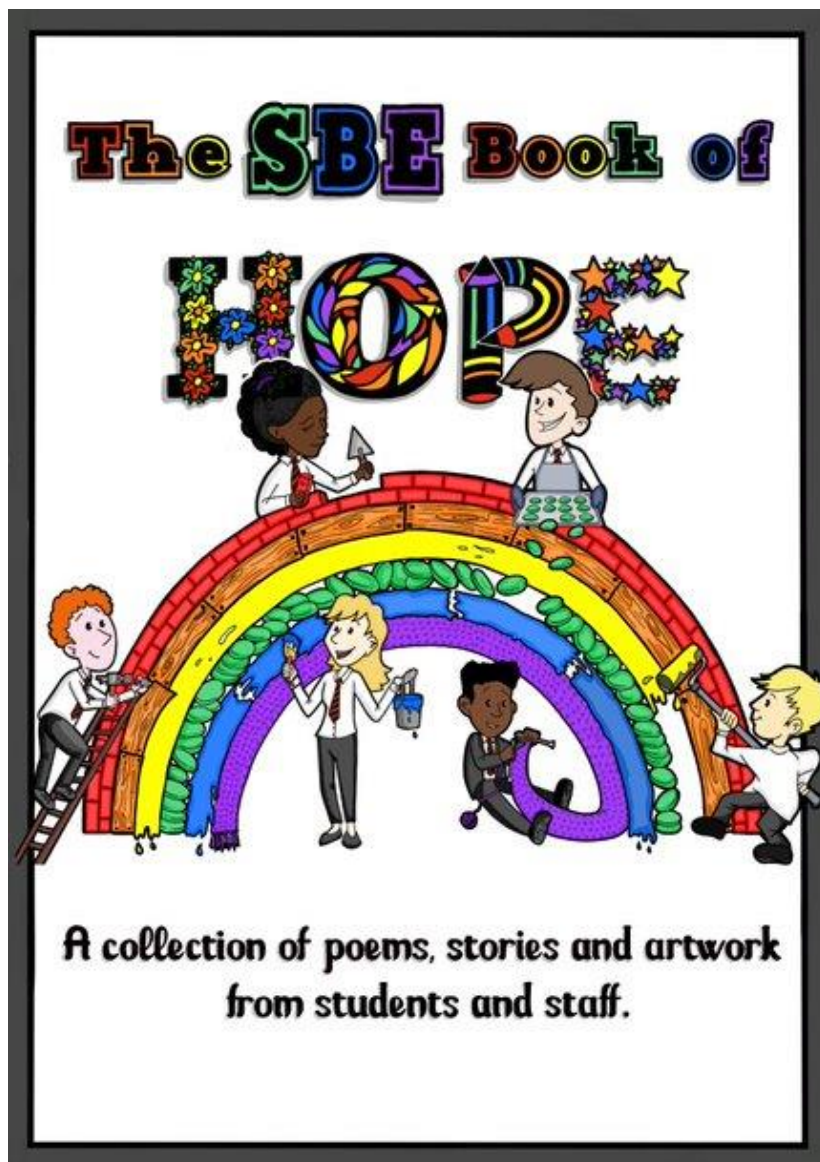


Competition Time
