



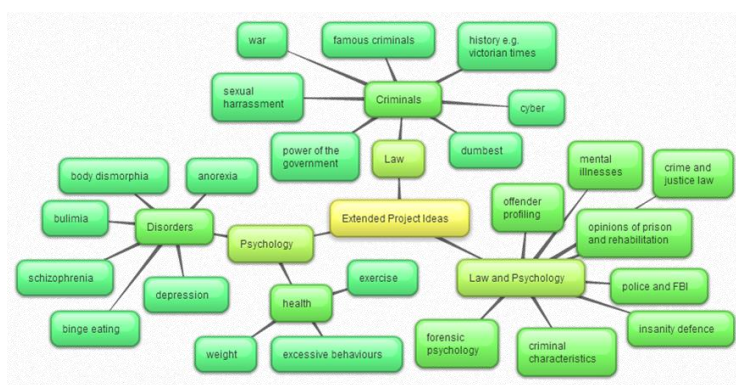

Summer transition tasks for
Extended Project Qualification

Due date Monday 11 September 2023

Objectives: by completing these tasks you will have undertaken some preparation for the EPQ project you will be completing throughout the year. This will enable you to start the course with some decisions already made, planning already started, and knowledge of your chosen topic already at hand. The skills you will develop are those of being able to research and understand the topic you have chosen to complete.

Tasks:

1. Pick 4 topics you are interested in- these could be from your EPQ lesson earlier.
2. For each topic create a small mind map of sub-topics you could cover and questions you could propose for your title.
3. For each topic -choose one question from your planning and write down 5 areas or points you would want to cover when answering the question.
4. Narrow down your topics to 2 based on your planning. Which two are the most likely choices for you to take forward? Once you have narrowed down to two topics, for each topic write a 500-word summary of the topic including what you want to find out and answer by the end of the project (this will form part of your draft introduction when you return).
5. Extension activity- begin some research on your final two topics- make sure you note down WHERE you got the information from and how useful it is.



What you need to submit: You will need to submit the planning documents and the summary of the two final topics you will eventually choose from. This can be done on PowerPoint, Word or written format- all of which need to be PRINTED off and brought in as you will use this in your first lesson and show this to your EPQ teacher.
